

INDEPENDENT LIVING



Each Independent living community generally has the following:

- An emergency communication system (pull cord and/or pendants)
- Meal plans can include 2-3 meals a day and snacks, depending on resident preferences
- Weekly housekeeping
- Weekly laundry of linens, washer, and dryer, sometimes in unit
- Fully accessible bathroom and grab bars, easy-to-use shower
- Basic cable, internet, and all utilities (except personal phone)
- Each community has some amenities and activities specific to that location
- Transportation to medical appointments
- Weekly shopping trips and excursions

There is base rent for each apartment which typically includes the items noted above.

The average base rent can run:

- \$2,900 a month for a studio
- \$3,900 a month for a one-bedroom
- \$5,000 a month for a two-bedroom
- Plus, a one-time Community Fee. (\$2,500- \$10,000)

Residents and their families typically furnish the rooms or apartments. Your placement advisor and/or move-in coordinator can assist you with any questions.
